Welfare and Accommodation Policy

The student will live with a parent or relative approved by the Department of Immigration. In this case:

- i. The Australian International Islamic College does **not** provide a welfare letter (CAAW) via PRISMS. The student's family provides proof of relationship to Department of Immigration for the purposes of visa application.
- ii. If the adult responsible for the welfare, accommodation and other support arrangements for a student under 18 years holds a <u>Student Guardian visa</u> (<u>subclass 590</u>), all obligations and conditions of this visa must be met, including:
 - o not leaving Australia without the nominating student unless the Australian International Islamic College has first approved alternative welfare and accommodation arrangements for the student for the adult's period of absence, and
 - o advising the Department of Immigration of any change of address, passport or other changes of circumstances.
